ARC Rutland Area is very grateful and excited to receive a very generous grant award from the Bowse Health Trust. Over the next three years, this grant will fund a new series of 5-week life skills courses for our members beginning this spring and taught by professional instructors on topics such as finance/ budgeting, reading for joy, basic cooking, holistic wellness, small tool safety, and other topics members choose.

Members who complete the course will receive a Certificate of Completion. To compliment the life skills courses, this grant will allow ARC to also host 2-4 professional health awareness clinics throughout the year.
